Student Parking



Student parking spaces will be allocated according to a lottery basis; with seniors receiving first consideration, followed by juniors. To receive consideration for a parking space, students must mail the parking form to the high school, along with a check to the high school designating "PARKING" on the envelope. The deadline for all parking forms is **Friday, August 5, 2011**. Students who have outstanding fees or fines will not be eligible to purchase a parking pass. Parking permits will be distributed when students pick up their schedules and all required student forms are completed and returned.

Lake High School Open House

Faculty members will be in classrooms on **Tuesday, August 30, 2011** from 7:00 - 8:30 p.m. to give general overviews of their course and classroom/student expectations. This is an informal schedule and parents can tour the entire building.

Lake High School and Paramount Photo want to remind all seniors that they must have their yearbook photo taken by the deadline of **Thursday, August 18, 2011**.

Photos must be taken by Paramount Photo, and are taken free of charge before the deadline. After the deadline, there is a short grace period that students can still be photographed for the yearbook, but there will be a \$25 (plus tax) late fee.

What you need to know:

*You **MUST** make an appointment.

*Appointments are already filling up fast, so get scheduled early. If you wait until August, you may not get in before the deadline!

*Paramount Photo is open 9:30 am - 5:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 9:30 am - 4:30 p.m. on Friday. All appointments must be made during normal business hours, no weekend appointments are available for yearbook photos.

*Students clothing must be within school dress code guidelines. Students should be dressed and ready when they arrive at the studio.

*A yearbook appointment only takes about 15 minutes. We take several photos of you, then allow you to select which one goes in the yearbook at that time. You may purchase prints of the yearbook photo if you wish.

Back-to-school Traffic Flow Reminders



Please be mindful of some key points when visiting the high school. **The bus lane is off limits to all traffic at all times except school bus traffic.** Keeping safety in mind, at no time should there be regular passenger vehicles in the bus lane; before, during or after school hours.

The Lake Center parking lot is reserved for high school faculty and staff as indicated by spots marked with a "T" and spot number. There are four visitor parking spots and two handicap parking spots in this lot. Visitors may enter door #1 and sign in at the main office.

Student parking is located in the King Church lot and Stadium/Park lot on Market Ave. If your child has an early dismissal or comes to school late, please use the King Church lot for drop off and pick up. Door #2 is used for attendance. There are also visitor and handicap spots available in this lot.

The King Church lot is designated for all after school activities. Door #5 should be used to enter the building. Please do not park in the public library lot on Market Ave. for school activities. Thank you for your cooperation.
