

PINNACLE INTERNET VIEWER

PIV is a web site that can be used to access your child's records. PIV is updated by teachers to reflect current information stored in the Pinnacle Gradebook. The Pinnacle Gradebook is the electronic Gradebook that each teacher uses to record student data.

PIV Features: Our Home-School Connection

- Real-time access to grades
- Real-time access to attendance
- Real-time access to assignment and test scores
- Missing assignment reports
- Ability to access data anywhere there is an Internet connection
- Secure access using unique student ID numbers and Pin codes
- Email notification with parameters set by parents

The grade average is only an estimate at a particular point in time and it can be affected by assignments not yet turned in, not yet graded, or not yet recorded.

When To Connect

PIV is available to parents and students shortly after the school year begins. It may be accessed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The data is in real-time. After you receive your letter with your child's ID number and Pin code, PIV is available.

How To Connect

3. Scroll to Pinnacle Internet Viewer (PIV)
4. Click on the yellow report card icon
5. Choose school
