

# Criteria for NHS at Lake High School

1. **SCHOLARSHIP:** GPA of 3.495 or above (weighted scale)
2. **SERVICE:** at least 75 hours of recorded volunteer service for school and community (from freshman year to time of application)
3. **LEADERSHIP:** at least 2 different documented positions (from freshman year to time of application)
4. **CHARACTER:** respect, integrity, honesty, responsibility... (confirmed through a faculty evaluation)

## How does the process work at Lake High School?

A student's GPA is the starting point for eligibility. All scholastically eligible candidates will be notified of eligibility shortly after the third grading period of their junior year. From there, a list of requirements is completed, documentation of all service hours and the leadership positions is confirmed, and the faculty evaluation is examined. Interviews are then scheduled with the Faculty Council, and final decisions are made the week of the interview. The Tapping and the Induction Ceremony follow shortly thereafter. A senior who qualifies and did not apply or was not received as a member his or her junior year may be invited to join during that same grading period.

## What requirements are in place for inducted seniors?

1. Continued strong, positive character
2. One confirmed leadership position
3. 25 hours of community service
4. Attendance of NHS meetings
5. Participation in the large group service project(s)
6. Completion of an ISP (Individual service project)
